Large rock garden in front, large gazebo in back.

3881 Bailey Ave | Cherie St. Pierre | Front, Side, Back | Cottage, Asian, Colorful | P R APS WSA
Pond with high waterfall and Koi, small rock garden, many flowers

3882 Bailey Ave | Cherie St. Pierre | Front, Side, Back | Cottage, Asian, Colorful | P R APS WSA
No grass in front and back, deck in back, flowers.

38 Brinton St | Anne Tarantino | Front, Side, Back | Colorful, Cottage, Eclectic | S NP APS WSA V
Food and refreshments offered while viewing restored 1925 home. Unusual and rare plants, perennials, wisteria arbor, porcelain vine, heirloom roses, native plants, annuals. Back offers shaded park like feeling, gazebo. Featured in Buffalo News and on local Garden Show.

40 Brinton Street | Cindy Ehlers | Front, Back | Cottage | S O WSA V
Perennial gardens including a shade garden in back yard; large organic vegetable garden. Serving free iced tea and sweet treats.

82 Brinton Street | 12 Grain Studio | Front | Colorful, Eclectic, Amateur | APS
If you want to meet your neighbors, plant a garden.

97 Brinton St | Faith Pham | Front, Side, Back | Cottage | APS WSA
Garden spans the front, side and back of the house. Buffalo in Bloom winner 2009.

50 Canterbury Court | K. Laynor | Front, Side, Back | Eclectic | APS WSA
Perennial flowers and shrubs with ground cover carpeting. Water barrels and water drainage/reuse.

Capen Boulevard Medians from Main to Longmeadow | Public
Many plantings of different annuals, perennials, roses. Note the end gardens on each media section in this public space.

91 Capen Blvd | Paul & Bobbie Bleckinger| Front, Back | Colorful | R V
Over 30 types and varieties of perennials including an over 70 year old trumpet vine, a 30 year old weeping mulberry, a variegated weigela, a dwarf Korean lilac and several types of evergreens

131 Capen Blvd | Mary Matteliano | Front, Side, Back | Cottage | V
Raised bed island in the front and back. Garden features a mixture of vegetables, herbs, perennials and annuals

135 Capen Blvd | Falkowski Garden | Front, Back | Eclectic
Front lawn, rose beds and mixed perennials and annuals. Backyard mixed perennial and annuals in sunny and shady beds, also vegetable and herb raised beds.

Englewood & Kenmore Ave | Kenmore Garden Club | WSA | Public
The Point Garden, a public space is planted and maintained with an array of annuals by the Kenmore Garden Club Federation of Garden Clubs 8th District. In the National Buffalo Garden Festival.

66 Englewood Ave | Restoration Society, Inc. WNY Empowerment Network | Front, Side | Colorful
A colorful collection of perennial and annual flowers bordered by a rich variety of hand picked rural creek rocks. We will also have resource tables set up with agency representatives sharing information about our programs and services.

Heath Triangle | Heath Street Block Club | Front | Eclectic | N | Public
This an ongoing project of the Heath Street Block Club with a grant arranged by Council person Bonnie Russell. Last year we purchased a sign for the area and with volunteers and professional help from Snyder Ridge Nursery, we were able to put in new top soil and sod. This year Snyder Ridge put plants around our block club sign. Thanks to our neighbors this area has been redeveloped and we are extremely proud of it.

35 Heath St | Martin Schultz | Front | Colorful, English, Eclectic
A small yard filled with garden houses selections of perennials.

130 Heath St | John & Darlene Colomaio | Front, Back | Formal
Dahlia, gladiolus, cactus, roses, hostas, scrubs, clematis, iris, fern, various lillies and others.

219 Heath St | Karl Kozlowski | Front | Colorful
A small yard filled with garden houses selections of perennials.

340 Hedstrom Dr | Irv Salisbury | Front, Side, Back | Colorful | APS
Border gardens of perennials, unusual trees & shrubs surround a front & back lawn with 9 foot Neptune statue fountain as focal point in back yard.

17 Highgate Ave | Adamczyk/Turkovich | Front, Back | Formal, Colorful, Eclectic | S N APS WSA V
Traditional landscaped front yard leads to a backyard furnished with a composite deck surrounded by multiple flower beds that include a shaded garden and water feature beneath a tree canopy

Larchmont Rd medians from Kenmore Ave to University Ave | Public
Public garden along Larchmont Rd median from Kenmore Ave to University Ave.

22 Larchmont Rd | Christine Brooks | Front, Side, Back | Eclectic
Colorful blend of annuals and mature perennials staged to bloom spring, summer and fall. Buffalo in Bloom winner four years running.

25 Larchmont Rd | Smythe | Front, Side, Back | Eclectic | APS
This perennial garden is new to the Capen Garden Walk this year.

43 Larchmont Rd | Sylvia Williams Ferguson | Front, Side, Back | Colorful | S WSA
Annuals, perennials and containers are featured in this garden.

81 Larchmont Rd | Lynn & Ken Richmond | Front, Side, Back | Cottage | R APS WSA
Our 4th year in the Garden Walk. More trees, scrubs, trellises, and stones and we are lovin' every moment we get to play in the dirt.

Main St between Bailey and Hertel | Main Street Garden Group | Front | Colorful | Public
Medians, side tree plantings and barrels that include countless perennials, annuals, shrubs, and trees.

Main St and Jewett | People's Park | Front | N WSA VG | Public
People's Park is a Buffalo Pocket Park/Community Garden at Main and Jewett. People's Park is a community space where people can come to garden, gather, and grow. The park has a butterfly garden, rain garden and raised beds. Many of the raised beds provide occupational training to developmentally disabled youth and Aspire, a program that serves adults and children with disabilities. The park holds summer art and science classes as well as events and music parties.

3269 Main St | St. Joseph University Church | Front | Eclectic
Although we do not have "a garden" we do have well manicured grounds that are welcoming and attractive. The church will be open on Saturday from 3:00 to 6:00 pm for services. You are welcome to stop in and visit.

1 Martha Jackson Pl | Anderson Art Gallery | Front | Sculpture
Seven large sculptures on site and green space surround the Art Gallery's parking lot. Informational guide available.

39 Merrimac St | Loni Lodwig | Front, Side | Colorful, Eclectic | R O WSA
An oasis on Merrimac Street for all in the neighborhood to enjoy. Created by a Master Gardener, this garden is constantly evolving - so be sure to stop by often throughout the year!

Minnesota Ave Community Gardens Main St to Bailey Ave | Minnesota Ave Block Club | Public
Four blocks of a one mile long stretch of cityscape, green space, on the center median of Minnesota Avenue, consisting of traditional perennial greens complimented by a palette of exotic floral color and design. Evening Garden Walks called, ""By the Light of Moon"" will feature ground & tree lighting in selected areas from Main Street to Bailey Avenue. The gardens will again showcase the unique feature of the ""Flowering Boulder"" created by Minnesota Avenue Block Club member - Pernell Carson. The Minnesota Avenue Garden Project is inspired by the national urban garden movement, engaging communities across the country to reclaim, refurbish and redesign the landscape of their public green space.

25 Minnesota Ave | Karen Robinson | Front | Cottage | N
This garden is new to the walk and features cosmos, cone flowers and Russian sage.

299 Minnesota Ave | Mary Walek | Front, Back, Side | Colorful
Front and back gardens combining perennials and annuals for color and effect. This is a beginners garden established as a gift to the neighborhood that has taken on a life of its own over the past seven years. Each year brings something new and different.

35 Montcalm Ave | Isabel's Garden | Front, Side | Colorful, Eclectic | S N WSA
Colorful, whimsical, front and side yard garden that is partially sunny and shady. A place where a garden gnome could be happy living in a mix of perennial and annual blooms.

35 Montrose Ave | Meegan Family | Front, Back, Side | Cottage
Our home, built in 1916 features a raised garden bed with many perennials. The gardens wrap the home on three sides and include some potted annuals and herbs in the quaint backyard setting. Our little quiet spot in the University District.

43 Montrose Ave | Pam Landel | Front, Back | Eclectic | WSA
Evolving small garden of mixed perennials and annuals with whimsical yard art and plant containers - "Walk the fence."

134 Montrose Ave | Linda Paul | Front, Side | English, Colorful | WSA VG
Corner of Montrose and Montcalm. Front and side of house open to viewing Colorful mix of annuals and perennials

116 Niagara Falls Blvd | David Cantaffa & Anthony Laulette | Front, Back | Cottage
Backyard retreat: vegetable and herb garden surrounding paver patio and yard bordered by a variety of perennials and annuals.

81 Northrup Pl | Linda & Bernard Kuntz | Front, Side, Back | Colorful, Eclectic | APS
This quiet, intimate garden was a Buffalo in Bloom winner in 2007 and 2008.

899 Parkside Ave | Rose & Phil Palisano | Side, Back | Colorful | WSA VG F
Combination of perennials, annuals, bulbs, vines and 2 fountains. Also vegetable boxes on deck and lots of colorful annuals in containers.

Radcliffe Rd & Larchmont Intersection | Templeton Park | Front | Colorful | Public
Large, round garden at south end of park under the pine trees. Showing daisies, dianthus, black eyed susans and assorted shrubs.
Radcliffe Rd medians from Kenmore Ave to Larchmont Rd | Public
Public garden along Radcliffe Rd median from Kenmore Ave to Main St which includes a small park.

51 Radcliffe Rd | Julie Loesch & Christine Corevera | Front | Eclectic | O
This year, our front garden "leaps" in its 3rd full season post planting. Organic lawn and plant treatment sure has helped! The back is under construction but be sure to stop and view it next year.

52 Radcliffe Rd | Denise Mills | Front, Side, Back | Cottage | R S N
No-grass front yard with rock garden. Cottage garden on the side and back.

184-188 Shoshone St | Paul & Emo Tarantino | Front, Side | Colorful | N S WSA
Colorful annuals, perennials, many hanging baskets at this meticulously landscaped and maintained 1930's building. Party Place is the name of this garden!

175 Stevenson Blvd | Connie Oswald Stofko | Side, Back | Eclectic | N S ASP WSP VG

Tyler St & Bruce St intersection | Tyler Triangle | Public
A small community park used as additional green space by residents. Recently residents along with a group of UB students have been working to maintain and improve the underutilized neighborhood asset through collaborative design and implementation.

University Ave medians from Kenmore Ave to Main St | Public
Public garden along University Ave median from Kenmore Ave to Main St which includes a small park.

2 University Ave | Ronald & Linda Young | Front, Side | Colorful
River rock wall, slate stepping stones, colorful ground cover in front. Brick and wood chip path on side with perennials and annuals.

12 University Ave | M. & G. Connally | Front | Colorful, Herb
Herb and urban rock garden that bees and butterflies seem to like.

20 University Ave | Hagstrom | Back | Colorful, Herb
Flower garden with many varieties of heirloom lilies.

44 University Ave | Lance Rintamaki | Front | Cottage | S
Cottage style garden, heavy with hostas, ferns, hydrangea, and assorted perennials. Backyard is under construction, but you can peek if you like!

74 University Ave | Wiktorowski | Front, Side, Back | Eclectic | P R S
Be sure not to miss the potted plants on the front porch and rear deck!

87 University Ave | Jud Mead | Back | Eclectic | APS
Big, architectural scheme.

93 University Ave | Peter & Melissa Hudecki | Front, Side, Back | Eclectic | P S V
Small garden in the back with pond and vegetable garden. A lot of different plants. Shade garden on the side.

Front perennial garden and backyard trellised vines. Outdoor living area with fountain. Buffalo in Bloom winner 2002

Public garden along Radcliffe Rd median from Kenmore Ave to Main St which includes a small park.

Shady yard and garden with perennials and an ivy-floored mini forest. Annuals and perennials in beds highlight neighborhood maintained medians on Winderemere Blvd
